**Dear Guest,**

We are sure that you are excited & getting ready to attend the wedding of Anjhula & Satish. Although, you will be quite busy in attending the different wedding functions each day, there is some down time available as well.

To make your visit to India adventurous & wholesome, we are offering different activities for you to choose during your down time. *Some of the activities are included and have been taken care of by your hosts, rests are paid options and you need to sign up in advance as space is limited:*

- ❖ **Hot air balloon**
- ❖ **Local train ride – very *aesthetic*, British era meter gauge train**
- ❖ **Jeep safari**
- ❖ **Henna (mehndi) painting on hands and feet – ladies special**
- ❖ **Ayurveda massage**
- ❖ **Talk by His Royal Highness of Deogarh on paintings**
- ❖ **Village Haat Bazaar**
- ❖ **Kite flying**

- **Ballooning** one hour free flights operated by international standard and approved pilots. Cost USD 250 per person per flight. 08 adults + 01 pilot in one basket / flight. Four flights are available, two each at dawn & dusk. Fly up to 32 pax in a day light (depends on weather conditions). Need minimum 16 guests to sign up to arrange it.



This landscape is situated on one of the most picturesque location of Rajasthan, bordering the two beautiful erstwhile Principalities of Mewar and Marwar. It has a commanding and breath taking view of the Aravali mountain range and the numerous lakes, strewn across the country side. And of course, the real beauty of India lies in its eye catching beautiful country side. In addition to the Aravali mountain range, one of the oldest in the world, there are some volcanic rock structures that tend to add immense natural beauty to the panorama of the area. No experience, other than a Hot Air Balloon Safari can give you the opportunity to experience this nature's bounty. It is almost impossible to describe the experience of enjoying this natural beauty, while floating leisurely atop of it in a hot air balloon.

- **Train** ride for 45 minutes. Two hours of round trip going by jeeps to the very interesting local railroad station and back. Cost USD 12 per person. Need minimum 10 guests to arrange it. Trip departs Royal Camps at 09:50 AM to catch 10:20 AM train.



It is said if one wants to experience real India, just take a ride in a local train. This also happens to be the highest track on the Western Railways in India. This train trip can come as one big, beautiful surprise! A ride on the local meter gauge train, down a mountainous Ghat section is interesting for its panoramic views and of the scrub jungle, hills, tunnels 100-foot high bridges and Remote one-man stations. One travels on the Ghat section and here the hundreds of monkeys descend from the forest trees to feed on handouts given by the villagers. One gets to see the real rural life in this Train. Talking to villagers and co-passengers can be really interesting sometimes. A guide accompanies the guests to help them to board the train & sometimes if the guests are lucky they might get a chance to sit in the driver's cabin and see the mind-blowing landscapes just from a feet distance. The 800 feet steep valleys, the thick forests, waterfalls (during monsoons), dark tunnels are a must see & an adventure not to be missed on. Enjoy the trip with a hot cup of Tea in the winters at the station or a chilled glass of coke in the summers with homemade biscuits (carried along by the guide). This journey ends at Phulad where your mode of transport awaits after a two-hour (21-km) ride of sheer excitement. The mode brings you back to the Deogarh Mahal for the lunch & followed ...by a relaxing siesta.

- **Jeep Safari for 2-3 hrs in Typical Royal style with Royal in attendance decorated with Royal emblem and lances. Cost USD 28 per person. Need minimum 10 guests to organize.**



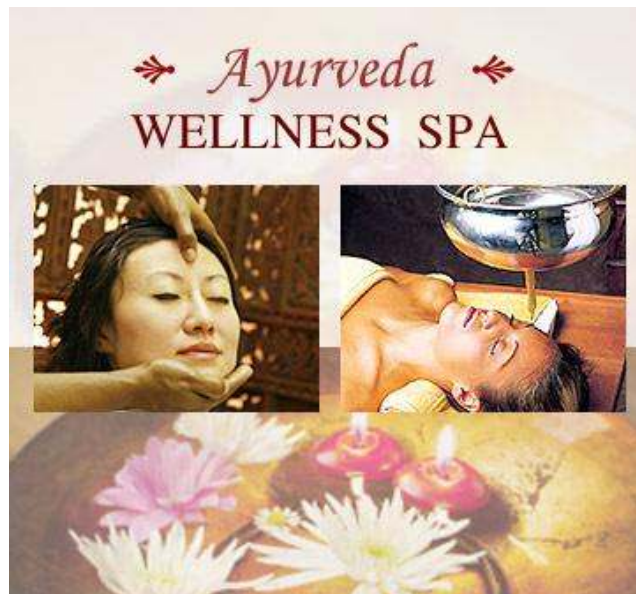
Jeep safari is the fastest and most rewarding way to explore the beautiful natural landscapes and cultural life and heritage of Deogarh. It can be enjoyed to visit the remote villages rich in ethnic and cultural life. Here you get the first hand experience of a typical Rajasthani rural life. The safari tour also covers ruins of old forts and very interesting temple complexes known for their rich architecture and history.

➤ **Henna Paintings.** Included activity.



The art form of henna or mehndi varies significantly from region to region. Varying designs have a different meaning for members of each culture, such as good health, fertility, wisdom, protection and spiritual enlightenment. Various shades of Henna are procured by mixing its paste with the leaves and fruit of other plants, such as indigo, tea, coffee, cloves and lemon. When used in decorative body art, sugar and oil are also added to the mixture to strengthen the color and longevity of design.

➤ **Ayurveda Massage** by Ayuskama. Cost USD 50 for one hour massage. Only men masseurs available.

Live pottery making, local shoes called “Jutti”, traditional bangles, varieties of saree from different part of India, miniature paintings, puppet dancers, Royal turban tying, Henna hand paintings is some of the major attractions at the Haat.
